FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE CULTURE CAPITAL GRANTS

Summary

Reason for Decision

The group will be advised to seek advice from Sports Development officers, and encouraged to explore sharing other local cricket facilities. The panel may then reconsider an application towards this project.
