Councillor Kirk:

Councillor Bone:

My thoughts on the distribution of the CIL payments is that they should be open to all parishes and should be based on merit on smaller scale projects so more parishes can benefit from them rather than much of the money collected going on large scale projects that would limit that wider scope for its use across the borough or areas that may not have an opportunity for development.

I feel that all applications should be considered on various merits, such as have there been significant development in an area that has increased the requirement of infrastructure to be improved, will there be match funding for given as demonstrates commitment to the success of a project and will it definitely enhance the local community. I believe these considerations should not be exclusive and other factors should be also looked in the allocation of funding.

Councillor Whitby:

First we need to decide how the monies should be split possibly 1/3rd for requests of up to £1,000. 1/3rd for requests £1,001 up to £10,000. And 1/3rd for major projects.

And as there are so many thing's and projects the money could be used for each request should go before a committee to look at its merits and how much new infrastructure is needed because of new dwelling.
