#### **Decision Taken**

Following consultation with the Leader it was agreed that the taxbase for 2021/2022 is set at 52.048.

#### Reasons for the Decision

The taxbase was estimated at 52,280 in the financial plan but there has been a transfer of properties on the council tax list to business rates list which reduced the taxbase by 123 band D equivalents. There has also been an increase in the working age council tax support caseload of 9.4% to date with more anticipated. A 10% estimate has been included which impacts the taxbase by a further 263 band D equivalents resulting in a proposal to set the tax base at 52,048.

To ensure the taxbase is approved ahead of the budget and council tax setting process for 2021//22. The taxbase is also required by County Council, police and prepared for 101 parishes in order to incorporate into their financial plans ahead.

### **Options considered**

Taxbase for the CTB1 is 52,311 which is higher than the estimate in the financial plan and includes the transfer of properties from council tax to business rates. The taxbase could have been set at this level but this does not account for the increase seen already with the council tax support cases. The taxbase assumes 100% collection rate. By ignoring the increase in cases, it would unrealistic to expect a 100% collection rate.
