Why do you think the issue warrants consideration by the Panel?

A very real danger that events will be held in the Borough that do not comply with social distancing instructions and involve large numbers of people interacting in small communities

Have you raised the issue with officers/the relevant organisation in the past?

I have raised this with cllr Kuhns and his officers are concerned that such events cannot be refused under the current licensing protocols

How can the Council influence the issue/what control do we have?

We can seek emergency powers giving us the power to refuse such events, on the grounds of public health
