1. Exclusion of Press and Public

3. To consider the report of the Monitoring Officer (Complaint 10/11)

The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.

The Sub-Committee considered the Monitoring Officer's report considered by the Local Assessment Sub-Committee on 1 April 2009. The purpose of the Sub-Committee was to consider the complaint against the assessment criteria agreed by the Standards Committee on 23 June 2008 and to reach one of the three following decisions:

- Refer the allegation to the Monitoring Officer which under section 57A(3) of the Local Government Act 2000, as amended, may be another authority – for investigation or some other action such as mediation or training.
- Refer the allegation to the Standards Board for England.
- Decide that no action should be taken in respect of the allegation.

The Monitoring Officer outlined the reasons for the decision made by the Local Assessment Sub-Committee on 7 October 2010.

DECISION
