Delegated Power

CAB 36 West Norfolk Investment Plan (Shared Prosperity Fund)

Authority to submit the West Norfolk Investment Plan to the Government in order to secure an allocation of £1.8m for 2022-2025 through the government's Shared Prosperity Fund, as set out in the report to Cabinet on 21st July 2022.

Delegated authority granted to the Chief Executive and S151 Officer in consultation with the Deputy Leader, Portfolio Holder for Business Development to agree the final submission of the West Norfolk Investment Plan by the deadline of 1st August 2022.

Decision Taken

The West Norfolk Investment Plan will be submitted to Government by 1st August 2022 to secure funding allocation from the Shared Prosperity Fund.

In the absence of the S151 Officer due to annual leave, the Financial Services Manager has been included in the consultation.

Reasons for the Decision

To allow the Council to secure a government grant funding stream to deliver the investment priorities for West Norfolk which will support residents and business to; build pride in place, receive high quality skills training, supporting pay, employment, productivity growth and increasing life chances.
