PURPOSE OF REPORT/SUMMARY:

This report invites the Regeneration and Development Panel to arrange for the appointment of Members to serve on the Informal Working Groups and Task Groups, which have previously been established by the Panel, for the Municipal Year 2018/2019.

The Panel has established the following Groups:

- **Riverfront Informal Working Group** – Current Membership: Councillors Collingham, Hipperson, Howland, Kunes and Westrop.
