

Housing Completions

Completions are still considerably lower in comparison to the same time last year. 215 completions between April and October compared to 415 for the same period in 2019.

A high number of completions are reported in October, 137. A combination of resources being available to check all sources of data in more detail and the fact construction sites commenced again after the first Covid lockdown.

We continue to wait to see if the Government will announce if the Local Housing Need figure will be reduced to reflect the impacts of Covid-19.

Local Plan review Update

Good progress is being made to finalise the document (and supporting documentation) to enable consideration and agreement by Cabinet and Council.

- The Local Plan Task Group will be holding a meeting on 2 December to finalise changes to the policies in the draft Plan.
- Supporting information in the form of the Sustainability Appraisal is being finalised.
- Other material including; the Viability Assessment; Habitats Regulation Assessment Report; and Duty to Co-operate Statement are in final preparation.
- Initial preparations are being made to put the document into our consultation system.
- This is a priority piece of work for the Council

Neighbourhood Plans Update

Activity has not only continued with this significant area of work but has intensified over the last few months. Within the Borough there are in the region of 33 parish/town councils involved in the Neighbourhood Plan process. Below is summary of some of those that are reaching crucial stages:

Awaiting referendum due to pandemic:

- Holme next to sea: passed examination, can be given full weight in decision making process. Awaiting referendum due to pandemic
- Upwell: passed examination, can be given full weight in decision making process.

In progress:

- Brancaster review: This one of the first reviews in the country, finishing the regulation 16 consultation stage on Monday 23rd November- examination taking place shortly after.
- **Thornham:** Completed the examination stage- now in the decision-making stage soon as to whether it can go to referendum.
- Tilney All Saints: Currently in the consultation reg. 16 stage running until Mon 28th Dec (examination follow new year)
- Castle Acre: Currently in the consultation reg. 16 stage running until Mon 21st Dec (examination follow new year)
- Hunstanton: Health check completed soon will submit for reg.16 consultation
- **Heacham:** Health check completed, preparations will take place on drafting NP and then will be submitted for reg.16 consultation
- Terrington St John: Soon may be at a stage to go to their reg.16 consultation stage
- Others which have progressed significantly: Gayton and Stoke Ferry
